St. Charles, IL – On June 15, the first ever St. Charles beer collaboration launched. The six breweries were: Pollyanna Brewing Company, Alter Brewing and Kitchen, Riverlands Brewing Company, Broken Brix Homebrew Shop, 93 Octane Brewery, and D and G Brewing.

Not only did they create a delicious Amber Lager, but, it was done for a great cause. A portion of the sales were donated to the Tri City Health Partnership. This non-profit organization, that started in 2001, is the only free medical and dental clinic in Kane County for residents that do not have the ability to pay for those services. This collaboration was able to raise over \$4,000 towards the organization and will have a great impact on their mission.

Tri City Health Partnership Executive Director, Kim Lamansky said, “Tri City Health Partnership is overwhelmed at the outpouring of generosity from the successful STC Six collaboration. Each of the brewers have reached out with their donations and it was wonderful to hear the joy in their voices, knowing the donation will truly impact the lives of our patients.”

The donations will directly impact the patients, helping them get the treatment they need. “We were blessed to receive over \$4,000! That donation will provide 20 office visits to the underserved in our community,” said Lamansky.
